



We take seriously the responsibility of being good stewards with the money entrusted to CP. We prayerfully decide where to allocate resources and strive to use the money as efficiently as possible. This year we delayed some building projects and some staff hiring due to our finances. While we received more money than we spent last year, a significant amount was designated for future campuses and upcoming retreat registrations.

As we all know, costs are rising. As a result, our budget has some minor increases. We did make some budgetary cuts to deal with rising costs. CP leadership carefully made decisions to ensure we are spending in areas that will promote mission (such as CP Kids and community outreach).
